

Our Professional Martial Artist Code of Ethics

All professional martial artists teaching at this school:

1. Shall assume responsibility for his or her performance and strive to improve teaching skills.
2. Shall strive to maintain the dignity of the profession by respecting and obeying the law.
3. Shall not intentionally expose the student to embarrassment or disparagement.
4. Shall not on the basis of race, color, creed, sex, national origin, marital status, political or religious beliefs, family, social or cultural background, or sexual orientation, unfairly:
 - a. Exclude any student from participation in any program
 - b. Deny benefits to any student
 - c. Grant any advantage to any student
5. Shall not disclose information about students unless disclosure serves a compelling professional purpose or as required by law.
6. Shall not misrepresent his/her professional qualifications.
7. Shall continue personal and professional growth.
8. Shall not make false or malicious statements about a colleague, student, or their families.
9. Shall not use disparaging comparisons of other schools or styles.
10. Shall not accept any gift, or favor that might appear to influence my decisions or action.
11. Shall cover exam requirements throughout each semester.
12. Shall use appropriate caution when working physically with any student.
13. Shall honor students' concerns for safety at all times.
14. Shall protect the student from conditions detrimental to safety.
15. Shall communicate to parents all information in the best interest of the student.
16. Shall play a positive and active role in school/community relations.
17. Shall respect the values and traditions of the diverse cultures in the classroom.
18. Shall not guarantee any rank.
19. Shall provide materials which are truthful and do not include any false, misleading, or exaggerated claims.
20. Shall not use my position and/or influence in anyway that may be detrimental to the physical and mental well-being of my students.
